

COMMERCIAL WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY (ONLY)

YOUR PRIVACY IS IMPORTANT TO US

We take your privacy very seriously and we are committed to protecting it. We believe that you should easily know what information we collect and use, as well as to understand your rights with respect to your personal information.

This Privacy Policy sets out how Paige.AI, Inc. (“Paige,” “us,” “we,” or “our”) collects, uses, and discloses information obtained through our websites, including paige.ai and its subdomains, (collectively, “Websites”) and the online services we operate (collectively, the “Services”) and applies solely to information collected by or in connection with the Websites and the Services and not those that Paige.AI does not operate.

Your access and use of the Websites and Services are subject to this Privacy Policy, and any separate Terms of Use for any of the Websites and Services that may be in effect at any time.

Please read the following carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If there are any terms in this Privacy Policy that you do not agree with, please discontinue use of our Websites and our Services. You may contact privacy@paige.ai with any questions or concerns related to this policy.

If you are a patient of one of our Provider Customers and have questions about your treatment or handling of your health-related information, you should check with your health care provider. Our Provider Customers are primarily responsible for determining how we use and disclose the Personal Information.

WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT

“Personal Information” is information that can be used to identify you by itself or when it is combined with other information, such as a name, address, cell phone number, or e-mail address.

We may collect Personal Information from you in various ways, such as:

Direct identifiers, such as your name, address, email address, telephone number, or an IP address or other online identifier. You may provide this information to us directly using contact forms on our Websites.

Geolocation and use information for our Websites and Services that may be automatically generated when you use the Websites and Services. We collect this information through Google Analytics when you visit the Websites or use our Services. Such Non-Personal Information may include, without limitation, your internet protocol (IP) address, geolocation as provided by the location services and GPS features of the device you are using to access one of our Websites or Services when location services have been enabled, browser type, operating system, the dates and times of page views, the duration of time spent at those pages, and if you linked to one of our Websites from another website, the address of that other website.

WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION WE GATHER

Our primary purpose in collecting this information is to understand your interest in our products and services and to provide you with better service. We will not use, disclose, or share your information except as described in this Privacy Policy.

How we use the information

In particular, we may use your information for the following purposes:

- Manage the Services we provide to you;
- Send you technical notices, updates, security alerts, information regarding changes to our policies, and support and administrative messages;
- Prevent and address fraud, breach of policies or terms, and threats or harm;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage, and activities;
- Conduct research, including focus groups and surveys;
- Identify and authenticate an account holder for our Services;
- Process and deliver the Services to you;
- Improve our Services and related products, other Paige websites, applications and marketing efforts;
- Provide access to free and/or purchased downloads and other similar content;
- If you have opted-in to receive additional communications, we may periodically send notifications about new products, special offers or other information which you have indicated are of interest to you;
- We may use the information to customize the website content presented to you and to align with your computer's operating system;
- To correspond with you, respond to your comments, questions, and requests, and provide customer service; and
- To conduct our business and perform related research, develop analytics, and aggregated data that allow us and our business partners to improve our Services and related products and services.

How we share the information

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties Personal Information we collect from you without your consent, except as described below:

- We may share aggregated data to conduct our business, improve the delivery of our Services, to develop analytics, and to enable us and our business partners to improve and promote our products and services.
- We may share Personal Information to authorized agents or third-party contractors whom we employ to perform tasks on our behalf and to the extent we need to share information with them to conduct our business or to provide our products, services, and offers to you.
- We may disclose Personal Information to third parties if we believe it is necessary to investigate potential violations of our Terms of Use, or to enforce those Terms of Use.
 - We may disclose Personal Information under the following uncommon circumstances:
As required by law;
 - If we believe that disclosure is necessary to protect ours or others' rights, property, or safety;
 - To comply with a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process served on us or the Services;

- In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we will disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets;
- If Paige or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets; or
- In connection with any other actual or proposed corporate transaction or insolvency proceeding involving all or part of the business or assets to which the information pertains.

Length

We keep your Personal Information only for as long as we continue to have a business purpose for it or as otherwise required by law.

Communications from Us and Other Third Parties

When you send email or other communications to Paige, we may retain those communications in order to process your inquiries, respond to your requests, and improve our Websites and related products and services. When you send and receive messages, we may collect and maintain information associated with those messages.

We may send you information by email on products, services, special deals, and promotions offered by us **or one of our partners**. If you are an existing customer, we will only contact you by email with such information where you have consented for us to do.

Where we permit selected third parties to use your data, we (or they) will contact you by email only if you have consented to this.

Out of respect for your privacy, we will also provide an option to elect not to receive these types of communications. You can also exercise the right at any time by contacting us at privacy@paige.ai.

Storage

The information that we collect directly from you is stored in the United States by us and/or our business partners for the purposes of providing the Websites and other services uses outlined in this Privacy Policy and by our Terms of Use and by submitting your Personal Information, you agree to this storage.

All information you provide directly to us online is stored on our secured servers which are located in the United States.

Some of the information collected through the use of cookies may be stored outside of the United States. See our section below on Cookies to review what information we collect through such cookies.

SECURITY

We will take technical, administrative, and physical steps reasonably necessary to restrict access to Personal Information to authorized individuals.

We strive to use reasonable physical, technical, and administrative measures to protect information under our control. To the extent we provide your Personal Information to any third parties, we will request that they use substantially the same level security measures to protect your information. If you create copies of information from the Websites or our Services, we cannot protect the security and privacy of the information contained in such copies.

LINKS TO OTHER SITES

Our Websites may contain links to enable you to easily visit other websites of interest. Once you use these links to leave any of our Websites, we do not have any control over other websites and their data collection practices. Accordingly, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide while visiting other websites, as those sites are not governed by this Privacy Policy.

CONTROLLING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Under applicable data protection laws in the European Union, the following rights apply:

Right to access and obtain a copy of your personal information: You are entitled to request confirmation whether we process any of your personal information. Where this is the case, you may have access to your personal information and to certain information about how it is processed. In some cases, you can ask us to provide you with an electronic copy of your information. In some limited circumstances, you also have the right to request portability of your personal information.

Right to correct your personal information: If you can demonstrate that the personal information we hold about you is not correct, you can ask that this information is updated or otherwise corrected.

Right to be forgotten/have data deleted: In certain circumstances you have the right to have your personal data deleted. You may make such a request at any time. However this right is subject to any legal rights or obligations we may have to retain data. For situations where in accordance with the law, we determine that your request to have your personal information deleted must be granted, we will do so without undue delay.

Right to restrict or object to the processing of your data: In certain circumstances you have the right to obtain restriction of the processing of your personal information, or to object on certain processing thereof on grounds relating to your particular situation.

To the extent our processing of your personal information is based on your consent, you also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawal of your consent will not affect the lawfulness of any processing based on your consent before the receipt of such withdrawal.

Regardless of geography, any person may choose to restrict the collection or use of Personal Information gathered by Paige in the following way:

INFORMATION YOU POST TO PUBLIC AREAS OR PROVIDE TO US

Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily make Personal Information or other private information available in public areas for viewing by third parties online (for example, on blogs, discussion forums, or other community posting or social networking sites), such information can be seen, collected, and used

by others besides us. We cannot be responsible for any unauthorized third-party use of such information, nor for the substance of any such user-generated content.

CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS

If you are a resident of California, you may be entitled to the privacy rights described below under the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”).

Your California Rights under CCPA

You have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your Personal Information over the past 12 months (“Right to Know”). You have the Right to Know (i) the categories of Personal Information we collected about you; (ii) the categories of sources for the Personal Information we collected about you; (iii) our business or commercial purpose for collecting that Personal Information; (iv) the categories of third parties with whom we share that Personal Information; (v) the specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you.

You have the right to request that we delete any of your Personal Information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions (“Right to Delete”). Once we receive and confirm your verifiable request, we will delete your Personal Information from our records, unless an exception applies.

We may deny your deletion request if retaining the information is necessary for us to: (i) complete the transaction for which we collected the Personal Information, provide a good or service that you requested, take actions reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, or otherwise perform our contract with you; (ii) detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, or prosecute those responsible for such activities; (iii) debug products to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality; (iv) exercise free speech, ensure the right of another party to exercise their free speech rights, or exercise another right provided for by law; (v) enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with consumer expectations based on your relationship with us; (vi) comply with a legal obligation; or (vii) make other internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it.

Exercising Your Rights

To exercise your Right to Know or Right to Delete, please submit a verifiable request to us by either calling us at {*enter toll free number here*}; or by sending an email to {*enter designated privacy e-mail here* }.

Only you or a person registered with the California Secretary of State that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable request related to your Personal Information. The verifiable request must: (i) provide sufficient information that allows us to reasonably verify you are the person about whom we collected Personal Information or an authorized representative; (ii) describe your request with sufficient detail that allows us to properly understand, evaluate, and respond to it. We may need to contact you to request additional information in order to verify you are the person about whom we collected Personal Information or that you are an authorized representative. We will not use any information provided as part

of a request, including any contact information you provide or that we request in order to respond to or verify a request, for any purpose other than to respond to or verify your request.

We will make an effort to respond to your verifiable request within 45 days of its receipt. If we require more time (up to 90 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing either by mail or electronically, at your option. Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period before our receipt of the verifiable request. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your verifiable consumer request unless it is excessive, repetitive, or manifestly unfounded. If we determine that the request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights by (i) denying you goods or services; (ii) charging you a different price or rates for goods or services; or (iii) providing you a different level of quality of goods or service.

These Functionality Cookies remain on your device for an extended period of time. When you revisit our Websites we recognize Functionality Cookies and remember your preferences or can automatically log you on to the website. Personal information on our system may be associated with Functionality Cookies but the cookies themselves do not contain any of your personal information. We do not use technology that recognizes a “do-not-track” signal from your web browser.
