

My Walk of Life Marathon - Participant T&C's

These rules apply to My Walk of Life Marathon 2020, and by registering and setting up a JustGiving page, you agree to the following:

The Challenge

1. My Walk of Life Marathon is a virtual challenge to raise funds for The Forever Friends Appeal - the charity for the Royal United Hospitals (RUH) Bath.
2. The challenge takes place from 1st to 30th September 2020.
3. **I will abide by Government and Public Health England guidelines on social distancing measures, throughout my challenge. Details can be found here: <https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus>**
4. I understand this is an individual challenge that I must complete on my own, in my own time. If I wish to carry out any activity with my friends, family and colleagues this must adhere to the Government guidelines.
5. My registration involves setting up a JustGiving online sponsorship page.
6. There are no age restrictions. However any participant under the age of 18, must have their parent/guardian register on their behalf. This is per JustGivings Terms of Use.
7. I understand that I can walk the marathon distance (26.2 miles) in any way I choose, but that it must be completed by 30th September 2020.
8. In order to achieve the medal, I understand that I must raise £100 or above and complete the challenge by 30th September 2020. Medals will be sent in October.
9. I understand that whilst the challenge is 'virtual,' it is physical and may be strenuous, depending on how I choose to complete the distance.
10. I confirm that my general state of health and fitness is adequate and that I am capable of completing the challenge.
11. If I have a medical condition or any concerns about my taking part, or my capability to participate in this challenge, I will seek medical advice from my GP prior to taking part.
12. I understand that I am participating at my own risk. In no event shall The Forever Friends Appeal be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever, including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspect of my participation in My Walk of Life Marathon.
13. Only registered participants are eligible to take part in the event and receive the benefits (fundraising support, finisher medal) associated with My Walk of Life Marathon.
14. My Walk of Life Marathon is **not a race**.
15. If I am unable to take part in the challenge after registration, I will notify The Forever Friends Appeal as soon as possible.
16. I am responsible for my own conduct and must not undertake any activities during my challenge that may cause danger or risk to myself or the general public.
17. I will not participate in any activities during my challenge, that may bring the reputation of the charity into disrepute.
18. I understand that if I post or tag media (e.g. photos and videos) on The Forever Friends Appeal's social media platforms, you automatically give The

Forever Friends Appeal permission to use and reproduce that content to publicise the work of the charity at any point in the future.

Fundraising

19. I will actively raise sponsorship for the charity via my JustGiving page.
20. **I will raise funds for The Forever Friends Appeal – entry is not permitted to support another charity.**
21. Any money I raise during the challenge must be paid to The Forever Friends Appeal as soon as possible and will be used for charitable purposes. Money pledged via online fundraising pages is collected and paid to the charity automatically. Please be aware, if you do not pass on all of the money that you raise, you may be committing a criminal offence. A failure to submit any money raised from any previous participation in events benefitting The Forever Friends Appeal, or a failure to notify us if you are unable to attend a previous event, may result in your entry being refused or cancelled.
22. I understand The Forever Friends Appeal reserves the right to refuse any registered walkers participation in the challenge at any time, if they breach the Terms & Conditions set out.

Use of personal data

23. By providing personal data when I register for My Walk of Life Marathon, I understand that my data will be used by The Forever Friends Appeal for the purposes of organising and administering the challenge. I agree that The Forever Friends Appeal can use the details that I have provided to discuss my fundraising activity. If you provide personal data on behalf of additional entrants, you also confirm that you have obtained their consent for such data to be used for the same purposes.

I understand my personal information may also be used for the purposes of sending charity communications, where I have opted-in to the GDPR statement upon registering for the My Walk of Life Marathon.
